

## **Out-of-School Learning Credit**

The Muckleshoot Tribal School Commission recognizes meaningful educational experiences can take place away from school and/or by persons not employed by the school district. It is the policy of the Commission that credit toward high school graduation may be granted for learning experiences primarily conducted away from the school and its certificated instructional staff.

Meaningful learning experiences leading toward graduation requirements conducted away from school and supervised by individuals other than school professional staff may include, but not be limited to: cultural activities/leave, travel study, work study, private lessons, educational programs and internships.

Procedures granting credit for meaningful educational experiences outside the school district will govern all decisions and will be made available to students, parents, and OSPI upon request.
